

## Visa fees

All visa fees should be paid into the Embassy's Bank Account using the Bank details below. Do not make the visa payment via Bank Transfer. You will be required to deposit the visa fee in person at any MKB Bank. The Embassy cannot provide any refunds for wrong payments. Kindly follow the payment instructions below.

The applicant's name and passport number is required when paying the visa fee. You must keep your deposit slip and attach the original copy to your visa application. If submitting two or more visa applications, the visa processing fee must be paid for each visa application. Please note that in addition to the visa fee, the bank will charge you a commission. You must ensure that the total amount on the deposit slip reflects the visa fee.
